Comments made by Bet-Nehrain AssyriaSat

It has been brought to the attention of the ASUK President, Mr Wilson Jaso and the Executive Committee, that comments made by Mr Sargon Dadish and broadcasted through AssyriaSat relating to action allegedly taken by the Executive Committee of ASUK to ban the Right Honourable Mr Yonadim Kana from holding a speech to address Assyrian members in the society premises.

The President and the Executive Committee would like to confirm that on Friday 27th January 2005, approach was made by the representative of the Right Honourable Mr Yonadam Kanna (Zawa) in order to book the club premises on the 16th February 2006. The Executive Committee acknowledged the request made and approval was given for the session to take place. Furthermore, the Executive Committee would like to clarify that at no point has the Executive Committee denied or restricted this request.

Whilst the Executive Committee continues the emphasis that the ASUK and the Assyrian House will always remain sovereign promoting Assyriology, cultural and community awareness in UK and abroad with no affiliation or association to any other organisation be it political or non-political, The ASUK and its Executive Committee will endeavour to continue support and assistance, as had done in the past, to any assyrian political organisation which believes has the interest of the Assyrian people at heart.
